

Couples League Rules and Events for Monday July 17th

Monday couples league is a two person scramble. A scramble meaning both players tee off and you choose the better of the two shots that you want to play and then both hit from that chosen spot. You continue that format until the ball is holed out and you record 1 team score. There are a few rules that must be followed and strategy used.

1- You must use each players drive at least 4 times.

2- You cannot use the males shot more than 2 consecutive hits.

3- You can move the ball 1 club-length from where it lies. However, the ball cannot be moved closer to the hole and it must remain in the some type of lie it was found. For instance, if the ball is in the rough it must stay in the rough, you cannot take one club length to shorter grass.

#10 Longest putt

#12 Closest to the pin on or off the green

#13 Longest Drive- not necessarily in the fairway

#16 Shortest drive

#17 Closest 2nd shot
